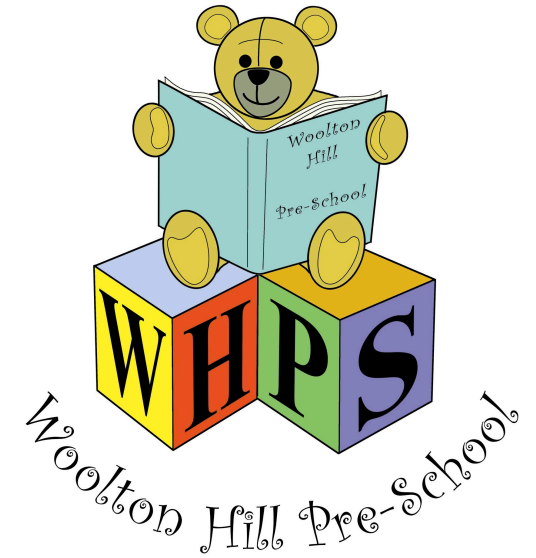

We offer a friendly, warm environment encouraging children to learn through play using the Early Years Foundation Stage.

Who are we?

We are a registered educational charity, run by a committee of elected parents and carers, employing qualified Pre-school staff.

We are a member of the Pre-school Learning Alliance and are regularly Inspected by OFSTED.

When are we open?

Mon- Thur 8am-3pm

Fri 8am-12.30pm

Lunch runs between 11.30-12.30. Children provide their own packed lunch.

Are the staff trained?

Our staff have Pre-school Diplomas, First Aid S.E.N. and food hygiene Certificates and are fully CRB checked. The staff follow ongoing training throughout their time at Pre-school.

What do the children do?

We provide a learning experience through structured play, using the Government's prescribed curriculum for all children called the Early Years Foundation stage.

We offer a safe, secure and stimulating environment in which your child will learn new skills and gain confidence before moving on to Infant or Primary school.

We also have a close relationship with St. Thomas infant school.

Register takes place at 9.15am each day. The children then discuss the day's weather, a topic and the school rules. This is followed by structured play, and a break where milk, water and a healthy snack comprising of fresh/dried fruit, vegetable or cheese crackers are available.

The children play outside whenever possible on our range of play equipment. Play, craft, games singing and discussion centers around child initiated topics and interests.

Can I see my child in a session?

Parents are expected to be part of a parent rota system, which involves staying to help for one morning per half-term. If a parent is unable to do this we are able to organize another parent to cover for a £5 fee.

Parents of new children are not expected to come in during their first half term to enable their child to settle in first.
